

## A natural part of the environment

The largest riding hall in the Czech Republic measures 3,600 m<sup>2</sup>. Designed by Astron, erected by Builder Partner E.PROXIMA, s.r.o., the sports hall is located near the town of Litovel and is in use the whole year round. The hall, with its free span of 36 metres, can cater for regular riding lessons and for special competitions. Due to its construction, and despite the large span, there are no intermediate columns neccessary.

One of the requirements planning the building was that the riding hall should merge well into the natural environment. This was achieved by using brown wall panels that optically look like wood and decoration that gives the impression that the hall is partly built out of stone.

The customer was satisfied with his new Astron riding hall.
